# **About TFQPH**

**The TFQPH is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization founded by the Tennessee Medical Association (TMA)**. Its mission is to enhance healthcare quality statewide by supporting the professional development of physicians, including strengthening physician-led relationships at every level of interaction- patient, peer, practice, hospital, community and state. Through innovative programming, the TFQPH addresses critical needs of healthcare professionals to promote effective leadership in medical practices, communities and beyond.

# **TFQPH Programming**

The **Ingram Institute for Physician Leadership** is the TFQPH flagship program charged with equipping physicians with the necessary leadership skills to adeptly navigate the complexities of modern healthcare. Named after 2004 TMA President, Dr. John Ingram, the Ingram Institute consists of two key programs:

#### **Physician Leadership Lab**

A multi-month course designed to help physicians develop leadership skills centered on strategic management and sustainable operational efficiency.

Participants cultivate core competencies in improving care processes, developing cultural accountability and leading change initiatives.

#### **Physician Leadership Immersion**

A two-weekend course focused on enhancing personal and professional competencies in areas such as teamwork, collaboration, conflict resolution, media relations and communications.

Participants engage in interactive discussions led by expert facilitators on a variety of core topics.

## Support the TFQPH

For nearly a decade, the Ingram Institute was fully supported by grant funding through a national nonprofit. That funding source ended in 2024.

To continue advancing a healthier future for Tennessee, the TFQPH must seek out alternative funding sources to cover program costs and maintain affordable tuition rates for incoming classes. This is particularly important for early-career physicians whom may have limited resources.
