In 2024, the Tennessee Medical Association (TMA) Public Health Committee met in 1 2 January, June and September. The December meeting was cancelled. 3 4 In Q1, the Committee discussed logistics for TMA's participation in a Middle 5 Tennessee State University (MTSU) opioid study via email to our membership. This 6 study consisted of a series of four emails TMA staff sent to our members studying 7 stigmatizations in treating opioid patients. The study concluded in Q2, 2024, and 8 results were presented to the full board in Q3. In addition to the opioid study, the 9 Committee also worked, during the year, with TMA member, Dr. Wiley Robinson, and 10 the Tennessee Bureau of investigation (TBI) on policy efforts aimed at reducing the 11 backlog of testing rape kits at state crime labs. 12 13 Previously in 2022 and 2023, the turnaround times the State of Tennessee had 14 required for rape kit testing had extended to 45 weeks. Due to efforts in 2024 of the 15 Tennessee General Assembly, advocacy efforts by TMA members like Dr. Robinson 16 and the TMA Public Health Committee, the turnaround times for these kits has 17 dropped to 10 weeks, according to media stories from various outlets as reported in 18 Q3/Q4, 2024. 19 20 On September 3, 2024, the Committee had its final meeting of the year to meet new 21 members and to discuss TMA's participation in the Medical Society Consortium on 22 Climate and Health (The Committee recommended the TMA join the consortium at
