The Tennessee Medical Education Foundation (TMEF) Board committed \$114,000 for 31 scholarships and \$15,000 in grants for the 2024-25 academic year for a total of \$129,000 in support of Tennessee medical students and education for residents and students. The Board meets in May to decide scholarships and grants for 2025-26.

TMEF's financial aid to students in Tennessee's five medical schools from 1997 to 2024 totals \$4,064,906.

Such established scholarships will be matched, as usual, by TMEF.

The ability of the TMEF to provide over **\$6** million in financial assistance over the last 50 years has been largely due to the ongoing support of the Tennessee Medical Association through its leadership and the contributions of member physicians.
