\$192,772

In the 2022-2023 FY, TMA PAC received **\$91,268** in donations from students, residents, spouses, administrators, executives, and physicians representing 31 different specialties. The average contribution to TMA PAC was \$485.15— up \$35.45 from last fiscal year. The largest contribution from a single donor was \$2,050.

Corporate donors were also very generous this cycle, contributing a total of **\$83,900**. TMA PAC received donations ranging from \$350 to \$50,000 from six different medical businesses.

Finally, TMA PAC received **\$17,603** from corporate and specialty society PACs, with the largest donation coming in just shy of \$10,000.

*In January 2023, the TMA PAC Committee voted to change the PAC fiscal year of 10/1-9/30 to a calendar year beginning in 2024. Thus, the 2022-2023 FY absorbed an additional three-month period.



Since the 2022-2023 FY was a non-election year, the amount of money raised this cycle was expectedly lower. However, the average donation amount actually increased by nearly 8% this year, even with a slight decrease in the number of distinct donors.




TOP DONORS BY SPECIALTY



Family doctors took the lead this fiscal cycle in terms of dollar amount raised, followed closely by internists. While there were 13 OB-GYNs and dermatologists each who donated to TMA PAC, OBs donated slightly more. Anesthesiologists took fifth place this year with 10 distinct donors.

Other top donor specialties this cycle include pediatricians, general surgeons, and otolaryngologists.
